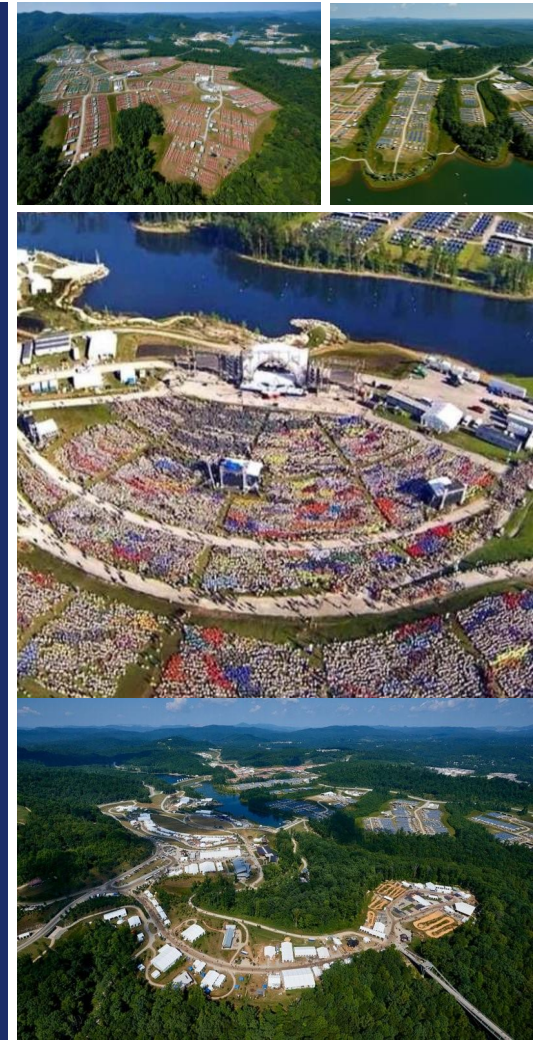

Background

Sponsors: United States, Canada, and Mexico.

- First time on the North American Continent since 1967.
- Participants from 152 Countries in attendance.
 - Largest World Scouting Jamboree – 45,000 scouts and 10,000 volunteers.
 - 1st ever High Adventure World Scouting Jamboree.
 - More that doubled the size of Fayette County, WV.
 - 3rd largest city in WV for 14 days.
 - 10,000+ acre site.

World Scouting Jamboree (WSJ) 2019



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Epidemiology Team

- **Screen Staff and Volunteers as they arrive – starts 2 weeks before the event.**

- **Screen all participants and leaders as they arrive –**
 - Arrive in groups.
 - Screening form provided to and filled out by Leader.
 - **IF:** there are symptoms indicated on the form.
 - **THEN:** that entire bus will be moved to an area and each occupant will be screened individually by EPI staff.

Public Health Surveillance During Jamboree

- **Collection of information and data daily from camp medical units on communicable diseases.**
 - Also monitored with syndromic surveillance with area hospitals and express care facilities.
- **Provide support for any specimen collection and testing needed.**
- **Provided daily report to the Joint Operations Center related to communicable diseases.**
- **Provided disease surveillance and support at the Isolation Camp.**

- **Refrigeration Temperatures – different standards in other countries.**
- **Did not understand or were not familiar with WV (USA) Food Safety Rules.**
- **Converting temperature from Fahrenheit to Celsius.**
- **Multiple visits to achieve compliance.**
- **Proper handwashing.**
- **Some of the Food Houses were doing very complex processes.**

Pools, Lakes, Camps and Bathhouses

- **386 Bathhouses on site – with Grey Water Systems.**
- **“Too many to count” Porta-johns.**
- **Hydration Stations for potable drinking water.**
- **4 “Temporary” Swimming Pools.**
- **3 “Man-made” Lakes for water activities.**
