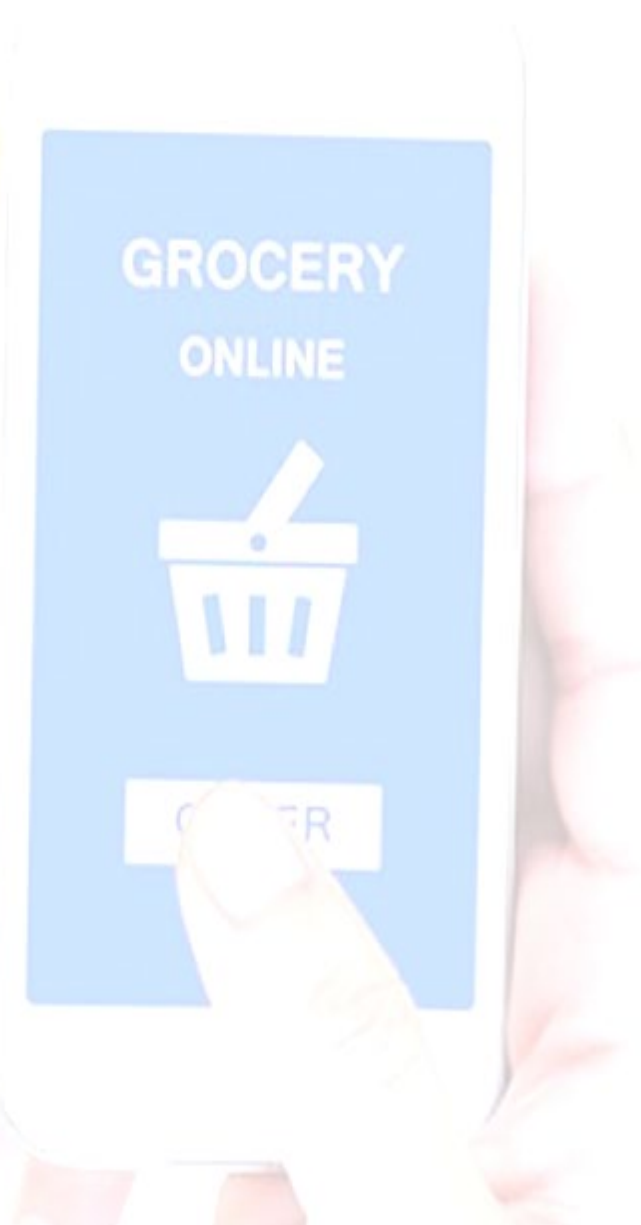
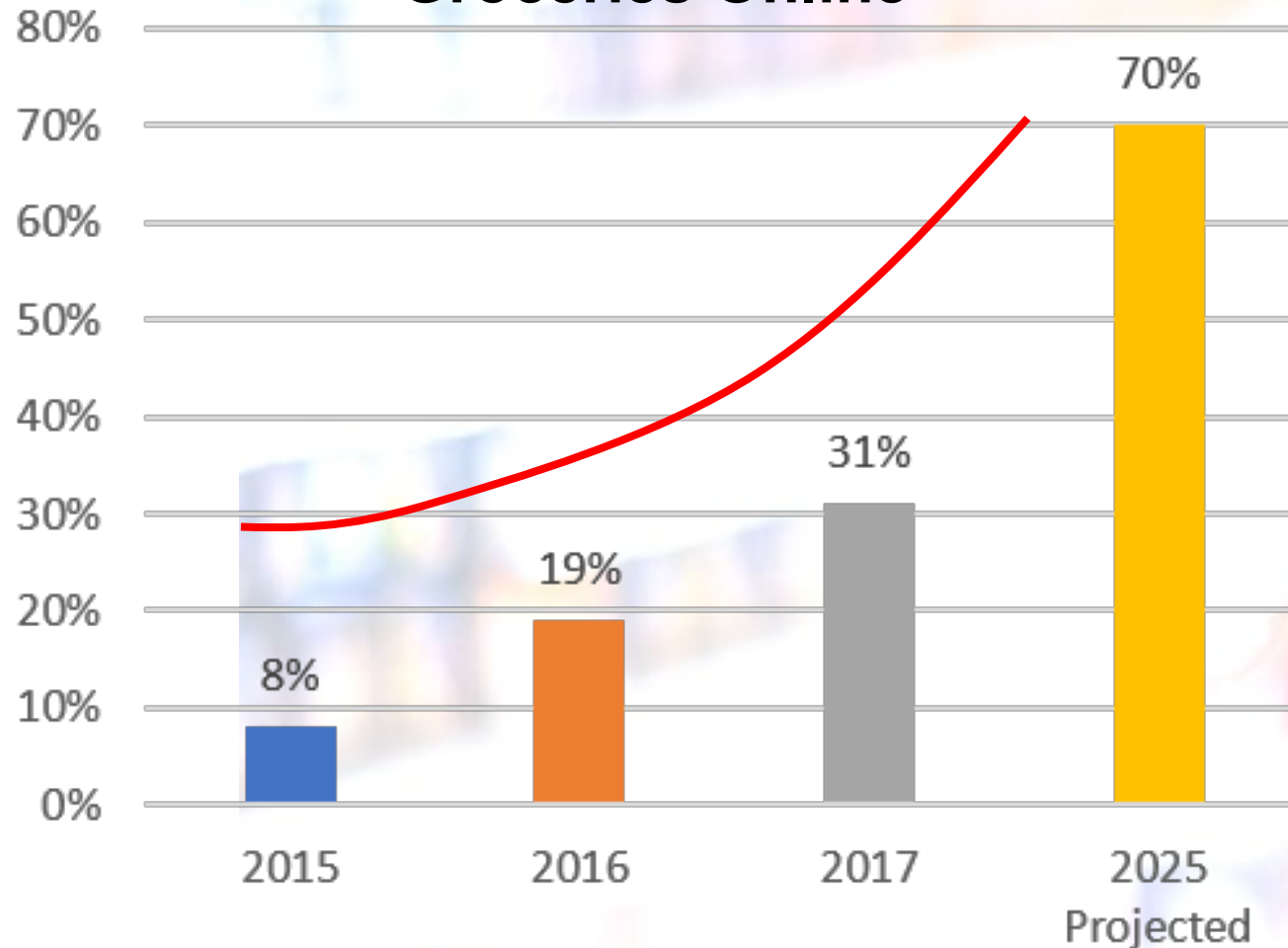

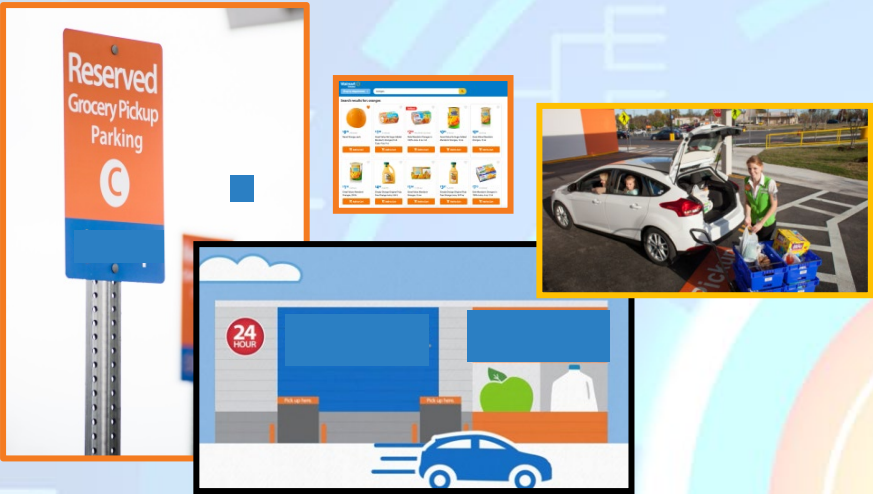
Percentage of U.S. Consumers Buying Groceries Online

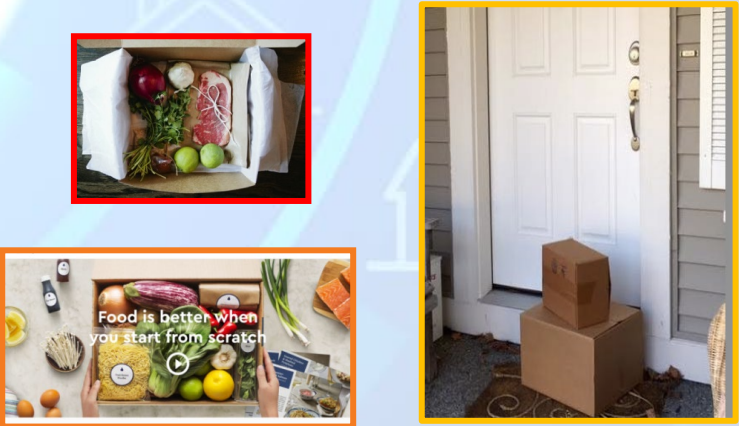

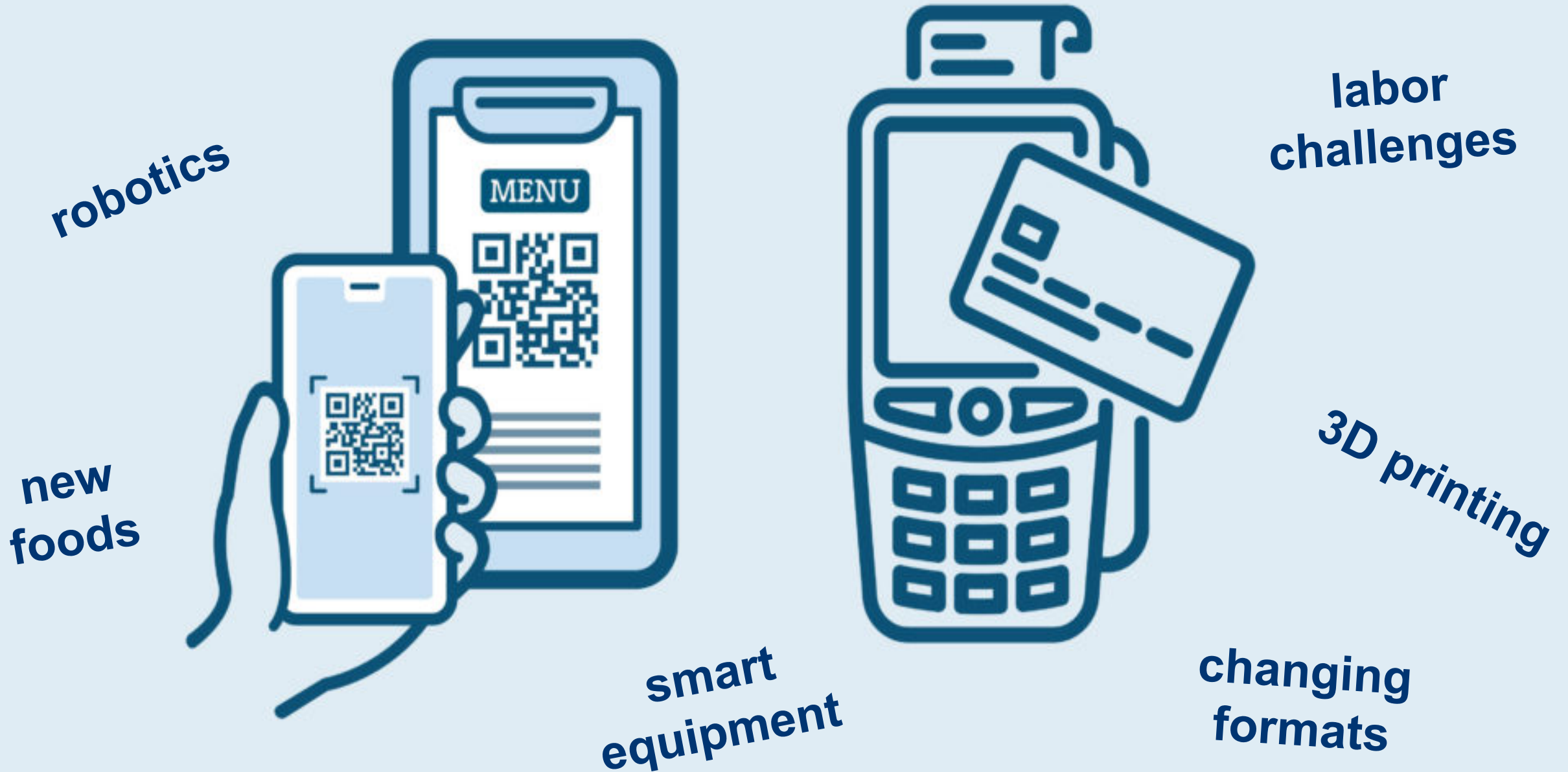



Food Safety Culture

- **Promote food safety culture throughout the food system**
 - Review literature and conduct research to determine approaches to influence attitudes and behavior
 - Advance food safety culture and behavioral science principles as a critical component of food safety work
 - Engage with industry and consumer stakeholders, as well as trusted regulatory partners at all levels of government, to develop and disseminate effective tools and approaches
- **Promote food safety culture throughout FDA**
 - Education and training of FDA's staff, alignment on values and mission
 - Exploring ways to assess and take food safety culture in account for risk prioritization (e.g., inspection frequency)
- **Consumer education campaigns**
 - Utilize new food safety technology and leverage tech-enabled mediums and tools, such as Smart Home devices, smart phones, and digital platforms, to promote food safety culture at home

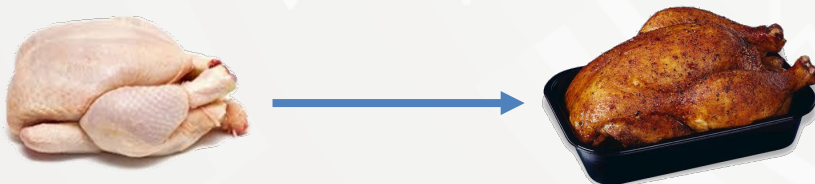

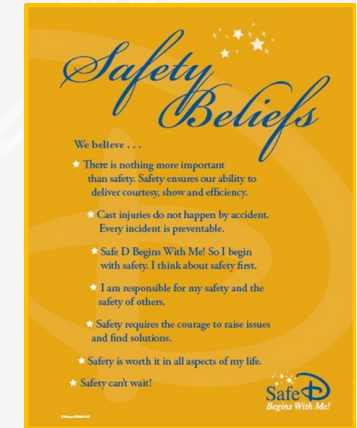
